We have 'un-picked' the local regs and expanded the details. Our intention is that by releasing this information now pilots and team leaders can become familiar with the local procedures and the first briefings will be efficient and can focus upon tasks. ### **Registration Stages for Competitors**

Thank you to all the Team Leaders who have supplied us with the initial information.

We have 3 teams who have supplied detailed stage 2 information. The deadline for Team Leaders to submit this detailed information is **April 19<sup>th</sup>**.

We have asked for additional information and [Angela](#) has sent out a revised spreadsheet with additional columns on it(P & X) , this is essential with regard to the **type of aircraft** and also the **licence** held by the pilot. This information is vital to enable us to apply for the CAA Overflight exemption for YOU. This is a complicated process, and we recommend that we manage this exemption for you and apply in bulk for **all** competitors with the exception of the UK team.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation and efforts in helping us.

These have been amended to include clarification on **insurance requirements**. It also includes the inclusion of two special trophies to recognise flying by young pilots and also first time competitors flying in a CAT1 event.
